JOIN THE MOVEMENT TO BAN FRACKING IN FLORIDA

FRACKING: A dangerous form of oil and gas drilling where millions of gallons of chemicals, water and sand are injected into wells, miles underground, creating fissures that release natural gas and oil.

FRACKING ENDANGERS COMMUNITIES BY...

- Depleting drinking water supplies.
- Potentially contaminating water supplies.
- Exposing nearby communities to poisonous chemicals.
- Negatively impacting local infrastructure.
- Releasing dangerous toxins into local watersheds.
- Increasing exposure to air pollutants.

Additionally, fracking poses a risk to the Floridian Aquifer, the source of freshwater for most of the state of Florida.
