But what does this have to do with toll roads?

It is time for the Task Force members to speak their minds about the toll roads and say "no build."

Yes, internet connection is a useful and wonderful thing, but no, we don't have to build toll roads in order to build rural infrastructure for broadband.

Broadband is carrot dangled in front of rural North Florida's nose to entice endorsement of unneeded and destructive toll roads. Another word to use is "bribe" to sweeten the pot.

During the public comments at least three people made strong points on the irrelevance of broadband to the toll roads. And they were right on the mark.
